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Who can be a mentor?

You can be a mentor if you are over 18 years old and possess the desire to help a child improve their communication skills, respect themselves and others in word and deed, resolve conflict with adults and peers, consider consequences, and focus on a career goal and life plan.

Who are the mentees?

Our mentees are youth in the community (ages 10-18 years old) who have expressed interest in learning positive communication skills, doing better in school, evaluating career objectives, improving their organization skills, etc.; some are directed by the court system to participate.



How YOU can become a mentor ...

1. Apply

Complete an application and interview; sign a confidentiality agreement; complete a background check and fingerprinting

2. Complete

Mentor Training Course (two 2-hour sessions)

3. Commit

Spend one hour per week per child for a minimum of one year

4. Attend

On-going Continuing Education Workshops
